## News from the Hess Lake Board - HLB

2021 has been the start of having Progressive AE partnering with our lake community for Aquatic Plant Control. Early in the Spring and Summer, Progressive AE surveyed and mapped the lake looking for both natural and invasive weeds. In May, Progressive AE instructed Savin Lake Services on specific locations and the specific chemicals to use to kill off the Eurasian Milfoil and Curly-leaf Pond weed. Progressive AE repeated their surveys monthly. The good news is that the invasive weeds did not come back to the extent which required no further chemical treatments. There has also been an increase in lily pads on the lake which will help to filter the water.

With the assistance of the Hess Lake Improvement Association (HLIA), Freshwater Physicians, Inc., was hired to net and remove some of the carp that are in the lake. The carp stir up the bottom, reducing the clarity of the lake. Unfortunately, this did not achieve the desired results. As a continued effort, the HLIA have built a group of carp cages. This type of cage has been tested and proven to be successful. Next year, these cages will be deployed around the lake with the hope to greatly reduce the carp population.

The United States Geological Survey (USGS) has selected a group of lakes in Michigan, Hess Lake being one of them, to monitor for Harmful Algal Bloom (HAB). A buoy has been deployed to collect information in the hopes to predict future blooms.

HLB 2022 meetings are scheduled for May 10, July 12, and September 13 at 9:30 am.
