- All shanties must have a name and address on all sides in 2" letters.
- All shanties in the lower peninsula must be removed by midnight on March 17; in the upper peninsula by March 31.
- It is illegal to clean and dump fish remains back into the water.
- More than one million anglers fish through the ice each winter in Michigan.
