#### Hess Lake Board Report

Bart Calvi from the HLB gave an update on the Health of the Lake. The HLB is currently on a 5-year plan to observe the Health and the amount of Recreation on the lake. The HLB and HLIA together are working to improve our lake. We need to remove the carp, bring back good plants, and kill off the milfoil. The HLB is on track to back decisions on an Alum Chemical treatment by 2024. ALUM (aluminum sulfate) is a nontoxic material commonly used in water **treatment** plants to clarify drinking water. In **lakes** alum is used to reduce the amount of the nutrient phosphorus in the water. To be able to use this treatment, we must prepare our lake.

### Carp

Member Roelofs updated that 53 Carp were brought in for the Carp Shoot.

Member Roelofs spoke about creating traps that have proven to trap carp. The association will give up to \$1000 to make Carp traps. If you would like to help or volunteer to use a trap once they are built, please contact Terry Reolofs 231-652-1386. More information regarding this can be seen on our Facebook page.

The netting of carp wasn't a big success, but we appreciate the residents that volunteered their time. Ryan Pendergast will receive \$100 from the HLIA for the use of his boats (gas).
