What is the difference between the HLIA and the HLB?

As we welcome new residents, we think it is important to clarify any confusion residents may have about the difference between the Hess Lake Improvement Association (HLIA) and the Hess Lake Board (HLB).

HLB

The **Hess Lake Board** consists of five people. These five people have legal authority to make decisions on behalf of lake residents, including taxing authority for any lake project they deem necessary. The three lake representatives are appointed positions, with the other two elected. The purpose of the **Hess Lake Improvement Association** is to promote a sense of community among its members including homeowners and summer residents. HLIA was created to work together on solutions for better water quality, to stimulate general property improvement around Hess Lake, and to plan fun annual community events.

The HLIA is a volunteer, leadership team that promotes community well being and plans social events for Hess Lake residents. *Unlike the HLB, we have no mandate to make decisions regarding water testing, property taxes, septic issues, etc.*

News from the Hess Lake Board – HLB 2022

2022 has been a very busy year for the Board. In January we applied for a grant from the DNR. The DNR liked our proposal, but unfortunately, decided to not give us the financing that we were requesting. We will monitor for more grants in the future.

Plant control was successful this year with Progressive AE not having to recommend chemically treating the lake. There was also an increase in vegetation found in the lake. There was an abundance of Lily pads, with Coon Tail, also being spotted - both are beneficial to the lake. 2021 and 2022 vegetation maps have been posted on the HLIA Facebook page.

Straight from Google: "Common carp are **one of the most damaging aquatic invasive species** due to its wide distribution and severe impacts in shallow lakes and wetlands. Their feeding disrupts shallowly rooted plants muddying the water. They release phosphorus that increases algae abundance." Thus, we contracted with Carp Solutions from Minnesota to determine the quantity of carp in the lake. Two nettings eliminated 396 carp which were mostly 21 to 25 inches in length, with a small group in the 14-inch range. The age of the carp range between 8 and 50 years old. It was also determined that there are too many carp to maintain a healthy a lake. The final report is due later this year, which will be shared with everyone on the HLIA Facebook page. Elimination of the carp is a primary effort moving forward.

The Board also contracted Streamside Ecological Services to assess Wheeler Drain. They recommended that some work needs to be done upstream in order to protect the banks and open the center of the channel. Dale Twing, our Drain Commissioner, has offered to contract Streamside Ecological Services to develop the engineering design to meet their recommendation. More to come as we continue to work on Wheeler Drain. The full report was published on the HLIA Facebook page.

In the spring a brochure about Shoreline Restoration was sent to each lake address. Erick Elgin, from the Michigan State University Extension, will be continuing to work on this. Stay tuned for further information.

LEAVES & GRASS CLIPPINGS

The **DNR** strongly discourages dumping leaves and grass clippings into a lake, river, wetland, or other body of water.

Leaves, grass clippings and similar debris add nutrients to the water that use up precious oxygen as they decompose.

Aquatic organisms need that oxygen!!

Consider Solar Lights for Docks & Rafts!

Protect your boat and dock from potential accidents when visibility is poor. A few well-positioned dock lights will help you avoid bumps and scrapes when docking in low-visibility conditions. Keep yourself safe from an accidental plunge into the water by illuminating the water's edge!


